Tickets, Fares and Passes

The cost of your journey depends on the number of sections you travel through. Fares per section are determined by the Ministry of Transport and IPART (Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal) and are reviewed annually.

Depending on your travel needs, there are a number of ticketing options available:

Single Ticket
For a single one way journey on any of our services.

Transfer Ticket
Need to travel on two Busways buses on your journey to or from the Campbelltown CBD? A transfer ticket allows you to break your journey within the transfer areas for no more than the cost of a direct ticket and much less than the cost of paying for both sections separately.

This means you can spend time in the Campbelltown CBD before travelling on to your final destination later in the day (you'll need to board your second bus within three hours from the time the transfer ticket was issued).

BusPlus
Do you regularly make the same train journey? Save time and money with a BusPlus ticket, a 7 day combined bus and train ticket, allowing unlimited travel on Busways and CityRail services between specified points. BusPlus is available from Campbelltown and Minto train stations.
