introduction

Bus services at Hornsby Interchange link with suburbs in the local area and also to the commercial centre of Macquarie Park.

Accessing public transport has been made easy by closely linking the buses with the entrance to Hornsby Railway Station, making it safer and easier for customers to make their connections.

You can catch one of the many buses departing Hornsby Interchange to the northern suburbs. Services to major centres depart frequently and many operate from early morning until late at night.

This guide gives a general description of bus services using the interchange as well as general information about the facilities available.

Access to buses is located on the western side of the railway station.

NightRide bus services



Nightride Routes N80 and N90 replace train services between approximately 12am and 4:30am daily, and operate between Hornsby and the City via Chatswood or Strathfield. These services depart from a designated bus stand in Station Street.

Trains



From Hornsby Station you can catch one of the many train services operated by CityRail. North Shore line services operate to the City via Chatswood. Northern line services operate to the City via Epping and Strathfield. Newcastle and Central Coast line services operate to Gosford and Newcastle.

Train services operate frequently seven days a week from early morning until late at night. For timetable and fare information visit 131500.com.au or call 131500.

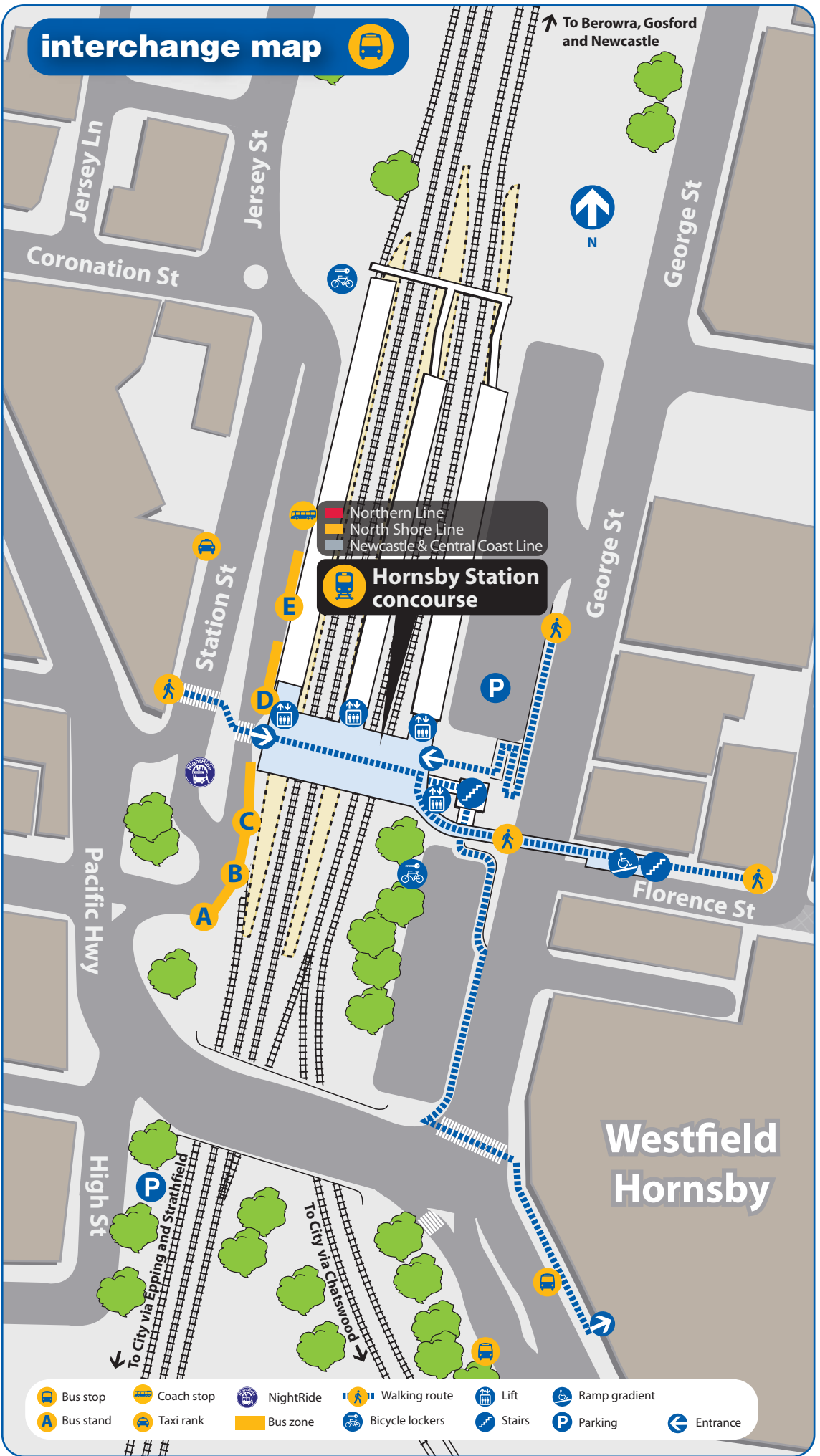

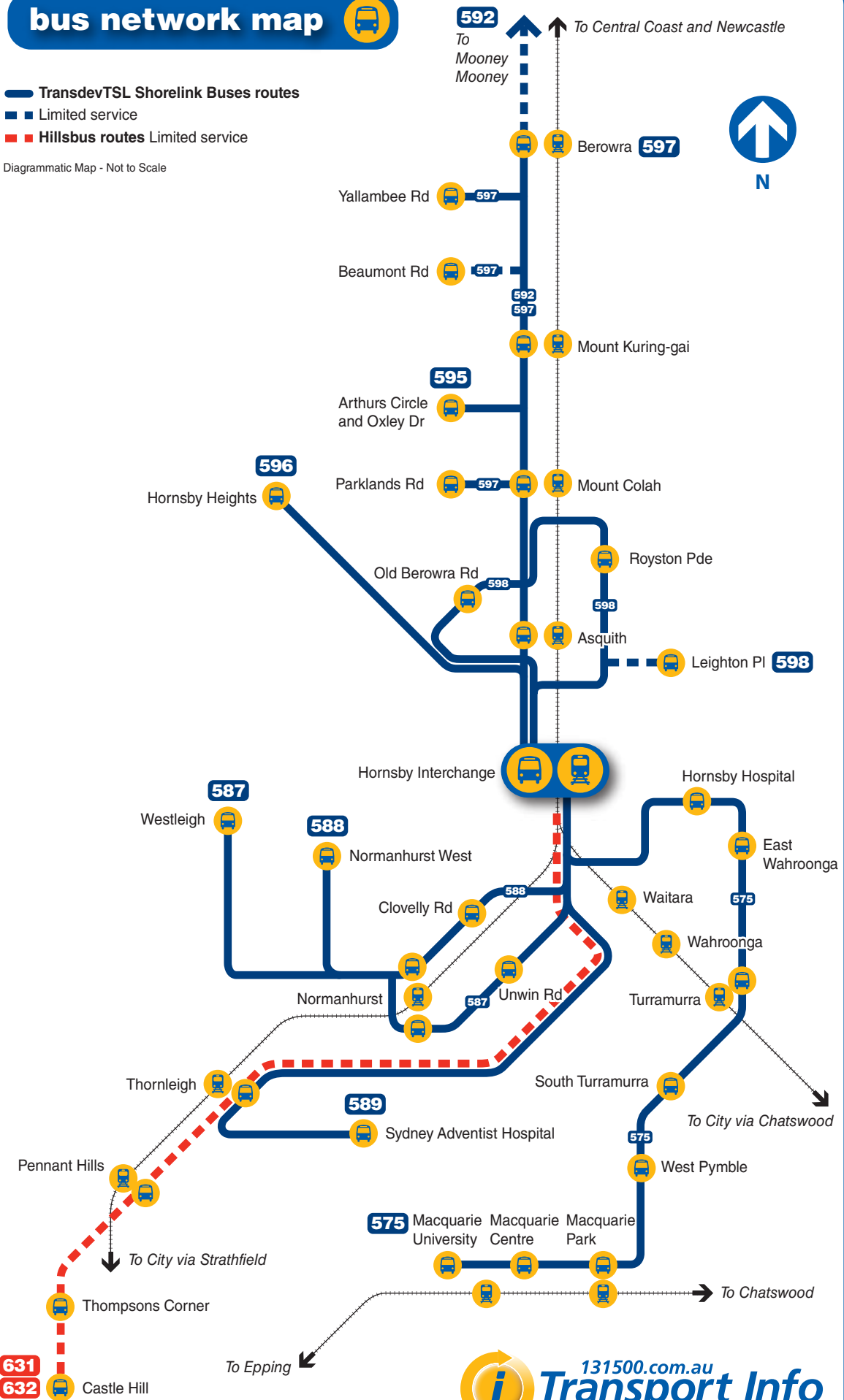
